Weather



Stay aware of weather conditions. Always keep extra cold weather gear in vehicles.

Decorations



Inspect light cords for damage. Keep live trees hydrated. Properly secure ladders when hanging or removing outdoor lights.

Travel



Buckle up. Follow the rules of the road and avoid distracted driving. Stay up to date on vehicle maintenance.

Kitchen & Food



Wash hands frequently. Do not leave oven or stovetop unattended while in use. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours.

Fire prevention



Burn candles away from children and pets. Check batteries in smoke detectors. Don't leave fireplace unattended.

Pets



Keep decorations and poisonous plants out of reach. Avoid feeding table scraps unless verified safe to eat.

Gift Giving



Consider the age of gift recipients. Small parts and magnets can be dangerous to young children.

Drunk Driving



Designate a trustworthy sober driver. Pre-plan a ride home by downloading a rideshare app and adding payment info.
